



Our Airborne Basic Courses in the US and in Europe have been a big success again since many years. Since 2013 we have been running Airborne Basic Courses in the Asian/ Pacific region.

INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS® will run its annual Airborne Basic Course in Asia to train local beginners in military parachuting on round-canopy parachute systems in June 2016.

Asian Airborne Basic Course 2018 will be conducted at an official Airborne School with NATO standard with military aircrafts!

Term: April, 29th through May, 8th 2018

The training will be conducted for the 4th time by the **Royal Thai Air Force Parachute Training Centre** in **Bangkok/ Thailand.** The parachute training program at the Airborne School of the Royal Thai Air Force in Bangkok will enable novices to join the qualification jumps.



The training will be conducted by <u>military instructors</u> at Airborne School following relevant NATO standards. Appropriate equipment like a <u>30feet jump tower, mock planes, harness and a PLF trainer</u> will be used in order to train participants to jump safely from an aircraft.

Host unit for the jumps is the famous Royal Cambodian Special Forces 911 Airborne Brigade!

INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS® will be present with 2 own instructors, 1 current NATO jumpmaster.

Three jumps by static-line (MC1) from helicopter Mi-17 are scheduled. Besides the jumps, more military-training like shooting and rappelling will familiarise participants with the skills and procedures of our host-units.

Parachute jumps will be conducted with the use of the <u>most common parachute system in the world</u>, i.e. the US military round canopy <u>parachute system MC1</u>. Three jumps will qualify the participant as a military parachutist and enable him/her to participate in airborne operations worldwide.

This Airborne Operation will be culminated with the award of the **Royal Thai Air Force Parachute Wings**, **Royal Cambodian Special Forces Wings** and either **Royal Thai Army Parachute Wings** (tbc) or **US Airborne Parachute Wings** (tbc) including official certificates:

Parachute beginner training:

ASIAN AIRBORNE BASIC COURSE 2018 is open to parachute beginners. Besides to the briefing in the parachute systems, jump-ships and DZ to all participants, novices in parachuting will receive an intensive training on:

or

- Safety procedures
- MC-1 round canopy parachute system
- Behavior in the aircraft and commands
- Exit-position
- Behavior in the air under parachute
- Emergency procedures
- Mal-functions
- Parachute landing falls

Details to the jumps:

ASIAN AIRBORNE BASIC COURSE 2018 is open to all non-current military static-line jumpers and novices in military parachuting who meet the medical fitness requirement.

Drop-zone: Jump-ship:	Kdan Roy in Cambodia, close to Phnom Penh MI-17 helicopter
Training and briefing	- In English language
	- On round-canopy system (i.e. automatically opening)
Parachute system:	US made MC1-1C (steer-able military-round-canopy system)
Altitude:	round-canopy systems around 500m (1500ft)
Jumps:	- 3 jumps, one dispatched by an US or RT Army jump-master

Requirements to participate in the course and jumps:

All jumpers and beginners must present on place:

- A medical certificate "fit for parachuting" (forms included the registration package)



- A third party (liability) insurance
- A foreign health insurance covering parachuting

Every participant will also be asked to sign a liability waiver to the host unit and nation and organizer.

<u>Important:</u> All the above documents are checked on place. Those who may not meet the requirements will not participate in the jumps and receive no refund.

Equipment to bring along:

- Boots suitable for parachuting
- Uniform: Either proper current uniform of the jumpers national armed forces or Tiger-stripe uniform
- National jump-helmet or black Protec Helm, but can be borrowed as well on the DZ
- For the ceremony national headgear of the jumper's branch
- Sport shoes and sport clothing

Training facility:	In Bangkok and close to Phnom Penh
Accommodation:	In tourist class hotels (3*)
Meals:	Asian food available at the HQ and Western food at the hotel

ASIAN AIRBORNE BASIC COURSE 2018 includes:

Military training part:

- Intensive training to fit a novice to do proper and save jumps by S/L at the Royal Thai Air Force Parachute Training Centre in Bangkok/ Thailand
- 3 jumps by static-line from Mi-17 helicopter executed by the Royal Cambodian SF 911 Briagde
- Opportunity to shoot with small arms with the Royal Cambodian SF 911 Brigade
- Opportunity to do fast rappelling from the training tower with the Royal Cambodian SF 911 Brigade

Military awards:

After completing the respective requirements, the participant will be awarded with following <u>Parachute</u> wings (in reference to the participant's qualification) including certificate:

- Royal Cambodian Armed Forces Airborne Wings
- Royal Thai Air Force Airborne Wings
- Royal Thai Army or US Airborne Wings (to be confirmed)

Logistics:

- Arrival day: On April, 29th the whole day to Bangkok and take a taxi to the hotel.
- 9 nights accommodation in tourist class hotels (3*)
- Flights from Bangkok to Phnom Penh and return
- All necessary transfers scheduled in the program
- All necessary entry fees scheduled in the program
