Operation Asia 2012

INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS® will run the next and 7th operation as **Operation Asia 2012** in this region in March 2012!

During **Operation Asia 2012** we will execute, **jumps** and **scuba diving in the ocean, shooting and fast repelling with** our friends from the **SF 911 Brigade in Cambodia**. In reference to your own qualification you may gain the wings of Cambodia by freefall or static-line jumps. Operation Asia 2012 will take place in a **time-frame of 7 days** while it may include sight-seeing in various interesting historical places. The participant may choose where to go and what to join. Term: March, 25th through 31st 2012. Additional add-ons may be booked around this term.

Views and live expressions of the great cultures will belong to the program. Plenty of **sight-seeing in the capital Phnom Penh and (antic) Angkor** may be complete the mission, so also accompanying wives and girl-friends will not get bored.

Parachuting, diving, fast rappelling and shooting with the with the **Royal Cambodian Special Forces 911 Brigade:**

Two jumps by static-line (Mc1) or free fall (with reference to the jumper's qualification) from helicopter Mi-17 are scheduled. Besides the jumps, more military-training like shooting and rappelling will familiarise participants with the skills and procedures of our host-units. On top we offer a dive training and dive in the Gulf of Thailand at the Cambodian sea-shore with our host unit's maritime detachment.

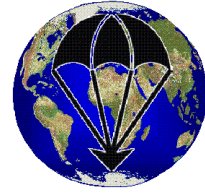

Operation Asia 2012 will host one more jump-master team to award its national Airborne wings.

The honouree award of the (small) Commando Badge will take place after shooting (AK-47 and pistol) and repelling from the tower. After the participating in the dive-training and following dive in the ocean, the participant will be awarded with the Royal Cambodian SF Scuba Badge with respective certificates.

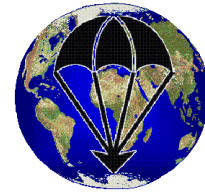


Commando Badge

Requirements for participation in the jumps:

Static line jumper must present on place:

- A medical certificate "fit for parachuting"
- An Airborne training certificate or parachute logbook with appropriate entries
- A minimum number of 3 jumps with round-canopy systems
- At least 1 jump during the last 12 months
- A third party (liability) insurance and foreign health insurance

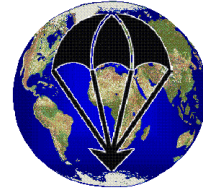
Freefall jumper must present on place:

- international valide FF licence, i.e > FAI B licence, USPA, BPA etc.)
- A minimum number of 30 freefall jumps
- At least 2 freefall jumps during the last 12 months

Important: All the above documents are checked on place. Those who may not meet the requirements will not participate in the jumps and receive no refund.

Every jumper will also be asked to sign a liability waiver to the host unit and nation and organizer.

The complete Operation Asia 2012 will include:

Military part including 3 days of military training with the Royal Cambodian SF 911 Brigade:

1 day: Special Forces training in the base:

- Airborne Refresher Training
- shooting with small-arms
- rappelling training from the tower
- obstacle course
- demonstration of the unit

2 day Airborne Operation:

- 2 jumps by static-line/ freefall (from Mi-8/17helicopter) executed by the Royal Cambodian SF 911 Bde
- Award ceremony in the base

3rd day: Scuba Dive Operation:

- 1 dive-training and dive in the Gulf of Thailand executed by the maritime detachment of the host unit

Military awards:

After completing the respective requirements the participant will be awarded with following badges:

Parachute wings (in reference to the participant's qualification) including certificate:

- Royal Cambodian Armed Forces Airborne or Freefall Wings
- One wing-set of a guest nation

Scuba badges including certificate:

- Royal Cambodian Special Forces Scuba Bagde

Commando badge:

- Royal Cambodian Special Forces Commando Bagde (honouree award)

Cultural program and sight-seeing- tours:

- Phnom Penh: Royal Palace, torture prison S21 and "killing fields"
- 2 days relaxing at the beaches of the sea-shore of Cambodia possible
- Optional antic temple and city of Angkor possible on extra charge to the operation

Logistics:

- Up to 7 nights accommodation in the barrack like accommodation or tourist class hotels (3*)
- All transfers scheduled in the program
- All entry fees scheduled in the program

Not included are the flights from you home destination to Phnom Penh and meals, drinks and tips.

Spectators:

Accompanying persons (for example wives and girl-friends of participants and up to 2 photographers) who are not joining the jumps are welcome in limited numbers to join this operation.

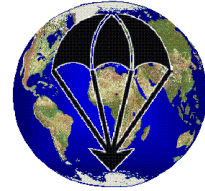
Term:
