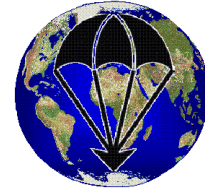

Dear Fellows,

This is the first time that we are executing a SWAT Operator course, one of the United States most professional unit in the world. The whole program is approved by U.S. State Department and will be covering the official program to become an U.S. SWAT operator.

Operation SWAT Operator 2012

INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS® will run the first tactical operation as Operation SWAT Operator 2012 in July 2012 in Luxembourg.

This 10 Day (100 Hours) course is designed for the law enforcement officer or military member assigned to handle critical incidents, building entries, or counter-terrorism. The course covers United States SWAT responses to such incidents. Students who successfully pass this course will be given a Certificate of Certification and be awarded a U.S. SWAT Badge to wear on their uniform.

The course curriculum covers equipment selection and deployment, advanced pistol and sub-machinegun/ assault rifle use, breaching techniques, building entry tactics, and mission planning. The course also includes multiple fast-paced scenarios designed to test you and your abilities.

BE ADVISED... This is NOT a 9 to 5 training program with a break on every hour for coffee. Training days may be 10 hours (or more) in duration.

This is NOT Boot Camp. Our Instructors will NOT be screaming in your face. However, this is a high-intensity, fast-paced course which is physically demanding and has a high ammunition count.

During Operation SWAT Operator 2012 we will execute, dynamic entries, tactical movement in urban terrain, mission planning, breaching technics, advanced shooting techniques of all tactical weapons (pistol, rifle), room domination techniques, tactical movement through the entire structure, working in teams of various size, scenarios.

In reference to your own qualification you may gain the badge U.S. SWAT Operator.

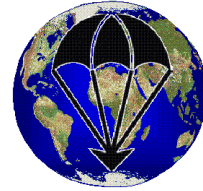
Operation SWAT Operator 2012 will take place in a time frame of 2 weeks only while it may be prolonged for sight-seeing in various interesting historical places. The participants may choose where to go and what to join.

Term: July. 16th to 27th 2012 included. Additional add-ons may be booked around this term.

Operation SWAT Operator 2012 will host two S.W.A.T. instructors to get trained by Inner Perimeter and Detroit Police. Award its national S.W.A.T tactics certificate

Training:

Covering:

- Equipment Selection & Deployment.
- Characteristics, Nomenclature and Function of Tactical Weapons.
- Loading, Unloading & Reloading Techniques of all Weapons.
- Advanced Shooting Techniques of all Tactical Weapons.
- Breaching Techniques.
- Building Entry & Movement through a Structure.
- Tactical Movement in Urban Terrain.
- Mission Planning.

Ammunition:

If requested, the ammunition can be purchased in Luxembourg, (see order form).

Requirements for participation in Swat operator course:

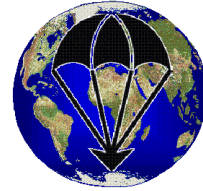
1. Must be active or reserve military / police agent/officer (Will be verified on place)
2. It's necessary to bring a insurance certificate concerning live fire shooting that show you are covered from any kind of accident at the range.
3. You will receive a listing with all needed equipment you must bring with you

Important:

All documents will be checked on place. Those who may not meet te requirements will not participate in the swat operator course and receive no refund.

Notice that you have to bring your military or police identification card with you.
