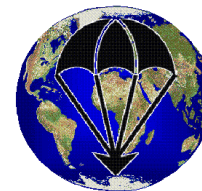


INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS



Operation with integrated military parachute training on round and square static-line parachute systems (also AFF- Freefall training possible) in Croatia!

All participants will be awarded with the jump-wings or Croatia in the respective level (Bronze, Silver or Gold) with certificate.

In case of 10 jumpers would like to jump for the US Airborne wings we will invite the respective US jumpmaster to award these wings on top.



US Airborne

Term: November, 3rd – 7th 2010

Place: Air-field Medulin in Croatia (close to Pula at the Adriatic coast)

Details to the jumps:

Jump-ship: AN-2 Colt

Parachutes: - MC-1C round-canopy, US System, which is in use in many nations worldwide
- modern square parachute systems for students

Absetzhöhe: S/L: rounds ca. 600m squares ca. 1200m
Freefall: ca. 1500m

Number of jumps: 3

Operation Adriatic Sea 2010 may be attended by experienced static-line jumpers on round or square parachute systems as well as beginner in military parachuting. A switch from one system to the other is possible, too.

Parachutes are packed by experienced rigger, no exhausting packing of the jumper himself necessary.

Details to the parachute beginner training:

Operation Adriatic Sea 2010 is open to parachute beginners. The beginner will be trained on square-canopy system. Besides to the briefing in the parachute systems, jump-ships and DZ to all participants, novices in parachuting will receive an intensive training in exit-position, behaviour below the parachuting, mal-functions and parachute landing.

Chief instructor and jump-master in charge for these operations is the very experienced military instructor of the SF, CPT Sasa Manojlovic (USPA - 186190 D – 26268; DFV - 7685 * DFV - 5412 parachute rigger, TAN - I * AFF - I * COACH * RIGGER) who actively teaches students in Germany and all over the world since many years. Our Croatian SF jumpmaster has been supporting us in several operations already and is well known in the Airborne community.

2 static-line courses are on choice for beginner and experienced jumpers:

- on round canopy system
- on square parachute system

On top we offer an AFF (Accelerated FreeFall) course on request. Also a trial AFF jump can be done during Operation Adriatic Sea 2010.

Requirements to participate in the jumps:

A) All jumpers and beginners must present on place:

- A medical certificate "fit for parachuting" (forms available on our website)
- A third party (liability) insurance and foreign health insurance

B) Experienced jumpers must proof on place on top to A:

- a) An Airborne training certificate or parachute logbook with appropriate entries
- b) A minimum number of 5jumps on the respective parachute system
- c) At least 2 jump during the last 12 months on the respective parachute system

Experienced jumpers who cannot meet 1 requirement are requested to join the beginner training.

C) Freefall jumper must present on place on top to A:

- International valid FF licence, i.e > FAI B licence, USPA, BPA or equal
- A minimum number of 50 freefall jumps
- At least 2 jumps during the last 12 months

Every participant will also be asked to sign a liability waiver to the organizers.

Organisation:

Minimum number of participants: 10

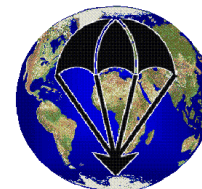
Accommodation: - In your own tent on the DZ for 2,50€ per night or
- In a pension in 2-4 bed-rooms including breakfast for 20,-€ per night

Meals: Cheap available close to the DZ

Meeting point: We meet on the air-field Medulin close to Pula
- transfer from Airport Pula can be arranged for 30,-€ extra charge

Arrival: on November, 3rd 2010 by 9pm

INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS



Departure: We will try to finish the jumps on Saturday evening already so that we can do party after the ceremony. At the latest we will finish the operation on Sunday as off 12pm.

Operation Adriatic Sea 2010 includes:

Training and briefing: on round or square parachute systems (i.e. automatically opening)
No of jumps: 3 jumps with rigged parachutes, more jumps possible on extra charge
Wings: Airborne wings of Croatia with certificate

Costs:

Cost for the course including rigged parachutes:	
Beginner course for static-line jumper:	490,-€
Switch of the parachute system:	490,-€
Experienced jumpers on round or square parachute system:	390,-€
Freefall jumper without own gear:	370,-€
Freefall jumper with own gear and without pack-job:	300,-€

1 extra static-line jump:	55,-€
1 extra freefall jump (without own gear) with rigged parachutes systems:	50,-€
1 extra jump with own gear and without pack-job:	25,-€

US Airborne wings award with certificate: on request

Transfer-option:

Transfers from the international Airports in Pula/ Croatia to the DZ in Medulin and return are possible on request and extra charge of 30,-€.

Registration:

Registration by info@internationalairborneoperations.com. Registration form upon request.

Since we need to pay the reservation costs for hotel, transfers and jumps in advance, a non-refundable deposit of 250,-€ of the course fee must be paid into our account to reserve your place on the manifest. The balance is to be paid on place.

Deadline for registration is October, 8th 2010. Only a limited number of places available – first come first served!
