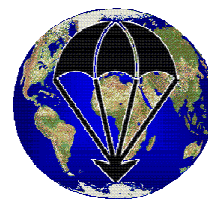


INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS



Operation Italy 2007



INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS will offer after many successfully Italian missions in the last 4 years again a military parachute course in Italy in September 2007. Pictures and report of the last year operation you can find by "Executed Operations" under "Italy 2006".

Concerning to the Italian Military Parachute System a soldier must complete the Airborne course (for foreigner this is NO beginner course) including 3 jumps first by a Airborne School of ANPdl, the national military Airborne association. At the end of the course he is awarded with the above Italian Parachute Brevet and this is reported to the Airborne School. The certificate with its own registration No is signed by the commander of the Italian Airborne School in Pisa. The certificate together with legitimating of ANPDI is send to the jumper by snail-mail around 4 month after the course. After the basic course the parachutist is qualified to attend Airborne Exercises with the Italian Airborne School itself and jump C-130 Hercules or G-222 Fiat of Italian Airforce.

In September 2007 INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS will run another weekend course (not available for beginner in military parachuting!) with an exclusive Airborne School of ANPdl at Reggio Emilia (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Reggio_Emilια). After the course the participants will get the opportunity to visit the beautiful city of Bergamo (<http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Bergamo>).

Meeting Point: International Airport Milan Orio (also called Bergamo). This Airport is also attached to cheap airlines like Ryan Air. The meeting point itself is the signed out "Meeting point" inside the Airport Milan Orio.

Important: We will not pick you up at the other Airports of Milan (Linate or Malpensa). If you arrive at other Airports of Milan, you have to organise your transfers to Milan Airport Orio (up to 100km distance) and also return on Sunday by yourself.

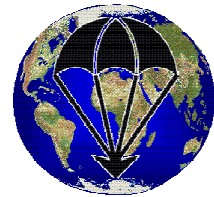
Schedule (changes are possible):

check in accommodation

- Friday: Parachute refresher course (no beginner training)
parachuting
accommodation in Reggio Emilia
- Saturday: Parachuting
Wings awarding ceremony
accommodation in Reggio Emilia or close to Bergamo
- Sunday: Parachuting (weather-day) OR
sight-seeing in the beautiful city of Bergamo
transfer to Airport Milan Orio and return home

Participants who would like to stay longer can do this on self-costs.

Details for parachuting at the A.N.P.d.I. club:

- jump-ship: PC-6 Pilatus Porter
- parachute: Italian military canopy (steer-able round-canopy)
- DZ: airfield Reggio Emilia
- jumps: 3 jumps with rigged parachutes, (no packing of parachutes)
- jump-altitude: 500m
- extra jumps possible: 50,-€ per jump

Requirements for participation on the basic jump-course

- national or international A-Licence for static-line-jumps **or**
- provable parachute-logbook, licence or certificate for successful completed parachute- course with round-canopy-system
- minimum 3 jumps with round-canopy-systems
- valid medical test "fit for parachuting"
- parachute-accident insurance

Equipment:

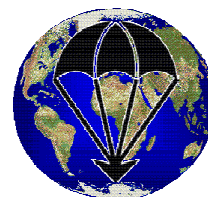
- national uniform (BDU) or jump-suit
- military boots fitting you for parachuting with round-canopy systems
- helm will be provided on the DZ
- beret or national military headgear
